**DISTRICT PRAYER REQUEST:**

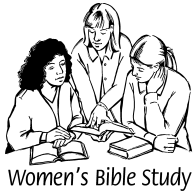

Lorna Lowe and Enid Mau.

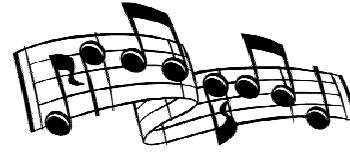
